

Join our 144 Envelopes Fundraiser!

This fundraiser helps support local business, the Leadership Academy, the Lewis County Mural Project, and the Lewis County Chamber of Commerce.

There are 10 prizes to win - each prize is purchased locally and has a value of at least \$400! With the grand prize being \$1000 County Ca\$h (a local gift certificate to use at participating local merchants).

How does the fundraiser work?

The fundraiser functions like a raffle where each envelope has 20-144 entries into the drawing and each entry is \$1. There are 144 Envelopes to purchase in total! Envelopes 1-20 each have 20 entries and cost \$20.

Envelopes thereafter cost the same amount as the envelope number, have the same number of entries into the drawing as the envelope number, and cost the amount of the envelope number.

Envelope 36 has 36 entries and costs \$36! Envelope 72 has 72 entries and costs \$72! And so on.

Once you've purchased an envelope the Chamber will print your name and envelope number the appropriate number of times, enter them into the pot for the drawing, and draw ten winners on the date of the drawing.

The drawing for the 10 winners is May 7th at 1pm through Facebook Live.

Croghan, Castorland and Copenhagen and showcases locally sourced and produced foods unique to the area. From goat farms, to cow dairies, to farmer owned cooperatives, the International Maple Museum, famous Croghan Bologna, and restaurants carrying local products, the Lewis County Cuisine Trail offers a little bit for everyone.
