Along the drive some of our local businesses have opened their doors for the day and are offering specials and events for you.





Inman Glide Trail Head will be on the right,
The trail head may be covered by greenery. Five parking
areas along Williams Public Forest Access Road.

Inman Glide Trail is a 3.8 mile trail located near Barnes Corners. This trail runs along the edge of Inman Gulf and through some hilly sections. Scenic Rainbow Falls may be seen on the north side of the rim and gulf.

Why do the leaves change color?

Leaves are made up of three pigments which appear as colors in leaves.

The first and most important pigment is chlorophyll which helps trees use sunlight to create food. It also appears as the color green in leaves and overshadows the other pigments.

The second pigment that appears in leaves is carotenoid which appears as the color yellow, orange, and brown.


The third pigment that appears in leaves is anthocyanins which appear as the color red.

In autumn sunlight decreases and the leaves respond by producing less chlorophyll. When the trees decrease their chlorophyll, this decreased amount of chlorophyll allows the other pigments to appear creating colors such as yellow, orange, red, and brown in the leaves.
